**NOTICE** is given that for 30 working days from 16 July 2024 to 27 August 2024 (inclusive), excluding Saturdays, Sundays and Bank Holidays, between the hours of 10.00am and 1.00pm and 2.30pm and 4.30pm any person interested may inspect and make copies of the accounting records of West Devon Borough Council for the year ended 31 March 2024 and all books, deeds, contracts, bills, vouchers, receipts and other documents relating thereto. The accounts and other documents will be available for inspection by appointment only at the offices at which they are normally kept; application should be made e-mail to the Head of Finance. **NOTICE** is also given that from 16 July 2024 to 27 August 2024 (inclusive), excluding Saturdays, Sundays and Bank Holidays, at the request of a Local Government Elector for any area to which the accounts relate, will give the Elector or his/her representative an opportunity to make written objections as to any matter in respect of which the Auditor could take action under Section 27 of the Local Audit and Accountability Act 2014. The written notice of objection must state the facts on which the Elector relies, the grounds on which the objection is being made and particulars of:

- i) any item of account which is alleged to be contrary to law; and
- ii) any matter in respect of which it is proposed that the auditor could make a public interest report under section 24 of, and paragraph 1 of Schedule 7 to, the Act.
